Cup in Memory of Fireman

A TROPHY to commemorate the name of Colin Hill, Sheffield fireman killed while rescuing a cat from a tree, was presented to the City Fire Brigade this afternoon.

Chief Fire Officer Mr. H. J. Reynolds received the trophy at the annual national competitions of Sheffield and District Works and Private Fire Brigades' Association in Endcliffe Park.

Mr Reynolds told "The Star" that the cup, given on behalf of the Association by Mr. W. Buxton, vice-president, will be for competition within the Brigade
