Death of Former Fire Chief

Ex-Supt. F. W. Hadwick a former Chief of the Sheffield Fire Brigade, has died at Louth at the age of 82.

He retired in 1923, and left Sheffield to live at Alford, Lincolnshire, in 1935. Before his appointment as chief fire officer in 1916, Supt. Hadwick had spent 13 years as second officer of the brigade in charge of West Bar station. He was popular with his men.

He held four certificates presented by Sheffield Watch Committee for meritorious and efficient service, and also the Long Service Medal of the Professional Fire Brigade Officers' Association.
